

Hand Appliqué *by Machine*

One Day Workshop Ring-o-Posies

Quilt finishes at about 18" x 22"



Notions

Stapler
Staple Puller
Large paper scissors (I use my best Gingher dressmaker scissors)
Small, sharp fabric scissors
Sharpie pen, ultra fine point, or a pencil
Freezer paper
Water soluble glue stick
Polyester Invisible Thread (Sulky or Superior brands **strongly recommended**)
Rotary cutter, ruler and small mat
70/10 Sharp sewing machine needles
Flat flower head pins (recommended, not required)
Small Light box (not required)

Fabrics

2 Fat Quarters green, different shades (light, medium and/or dark)
Large scraps or Fat Eighths (9" x 22" or so) in several shades of flower colors, (light, medium and dark)
1 Fat Eighth for the berries

Background

1 Fat Quarter

Binding and Backing (not needed for class)

1 Fat Quarter each

Sewing machine in good working order

Open-toed or clear foot for high visibility
100% cotton thread for bobbins in neutrals (if your background is light, you'll want light threads in the bobbin. If your appliqué is dark you'll want dark thread in your bobbin. You don't have to match the colors, but rather the shades.)
Remember to bring the power cord and foot pedal

**NOTE:

The machine needs to be able to do at least a zig zag stitch that is adjustable in length and width. Please bring your machine manual to class.

If the electrical system will allow, one ironing station for every four students would be ideal. A couple of cans of Magic Sizing (spray sizing) would be very welcome as well.
